


Credible... not Incredible

- The rule to let it burn was incredible and hard to justify.

Careful... not Careless



- Anne Bartlett paid her local taxes for 41 years.
- In Jan. 2010 she called 911 at 1AM.
- DeKalb County (GA) Fire Dept. responded. They didn't see any smoke, didn't get out of the fire truck, and left 5 minutes later.
- 6 hours later Ann's house burned down. She died.
- Firefighters did not follow proper procedures & rules.
- They were careless. Four firefighters were fired.
